Valuables: Each school will be responsible for their own valuables. Be sure to bring your own lock.

Check-In Time: Pick up envelopes containing numbers, badges, and heat sheets no later than 4:45 PM at the northeast ticket window.

Admission: \$6.00 - Ticket window will open at 4:30 PM. No admittance prior to this time. All qualified contestants in uniform, (6 qualified/relay only), one student manager, two coaches, athletic director, and principal will be admitted free to the meet.

Timing: Timing will be done by Greg Stuart Road Racing. He will be using FinishLynx.

Coaches & Contestants: Athletes and coaches remain in the south bleachers at all times. Only athletes actually participating will be allowed at the field events or on the track. No one is allowed in the infield. Please return to the stands as soon as your event is completed.

Length of Spikes: Spikes for both track and field events may not exceed one-quarter inch. (1/4") Hex-Head Spikes will not be allowed.

Field Events: All practice must be completed by 5:30 p.m. The shot and discus areas are concrete. The other runways are all rubber-asphalt. Contestants must have spikes no longer than one-quarter inch or jump in flats. The discus will be completed first.

High Jump: Bar will be placed at 4'0" for warm-up. Starting height will be determined by the games committee.

Pole Vault: Bar will be placed 6'0" for warm-up. Starting height will be determined by the games committee.

Advancers: 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place sectional winners in all individual events and relays plus any individual or relay team meeting the 3 participant standard in the sectional finals of their event. If the top 3 finishers plus the 3 participant standard advancers in an event is less than 16, the next best performances from the corresponding sectionals shall be added to bring the total number of entrants to 16 in each event. An individual or relay team shall not advance to the regional from the sectional finals unless the time is recorded by fully automatic timing (FAT)

Clerk of Course: At the 1st call, all running event participants **must** report to the clerk (red bench) located at the east end of the track behind the start of the 110M hurdles.

Closed TV: This is for the use of the starter, assistant starter, and head finish judge, if **Circuit** needed to clarify a finish place. No other officials or coaches will be extended the use of it.

Discus Shot Put: In the trials the competitors will be arranged with the weakest performer first and the best performer last. In the finals – competitors shall be in the reverse order of performance so that the best qualifier will compete last and the weakest first.

Seeding: Each center school **shall** conduct an E-MAIL or FAX seeding meeting as follows:

1. Participants must be entered in an event with a time/distance/height prior to 11:59 p.m. Wednesday, May 11, 2022, without penalty.
2. Each center school shall POST TO A WEBSITE clearly communicated in meet information, E-MAIL or FAX participating schools a copy of the seeds prior to noon, Saturday, May 14, 2022.
3. Corrections of obvious errors and/or omissions will be accepted by 4:00 p.m., Friday, May 13, 2022 if reported directly to the assistant commissioner and accompanied by \$200.00. No changes for the purpose of gaining a competitive edge will be allowed.

Awards: Trophy to the Championship Team. Ribbons to contestants placing 1st thru 8th in each event. All ribbons will be kept in team envelopes to be picked up at the press box at the conclusion of the meet.

Scratches: From Sectional to Regional
Qualified contestants may be scratched from an event without penalty, if reported by the coach to the tournament director before leaving the tournament and within 30 minutes after the conclusion of the final event of the meet.
